Phase-2 (PGU2 Project) which aired on TV1, Radio Television Malaysia (RTM) on 14 December 1991. He also directed the production video for the construction of several landmarks and mega projects in Malaysia such as Kuala Lumpur International Airport (KLIA), mosques Federal Territory, Pergau Dam, processing and Refining Plant Petronas, Formula One (F1) and PETRONAS MotoGP, All-Asian Satellite Television and Radio Operator (ASTRO), and several more. He has been a lecturer at the Faculty of Creative Writing and film since 2008 and in 2017, he was appointed dean at the Faculty of writing Creative and film and will retire in 2024.
